PAS School for Young Neurologists | Requirements to Host

Due to the highly interactive nature of the School programs, a number of important criteria need to be met by potential host centers.

- 1. The host institution must be able to provide 12 examination areas in close proximity to each other, to accommodate the easy rotation of 12 groups of 4 students between cases.
- 2. The institution should be able to recruit a wide range of patients with different Movement Disorders to participate in the examinations.
- 3. There should be space to hold catered tea/coffee and lunch breaks for up to 100 people (faculty, students, staff, patients and caregivers).
- 4. A lecture theater should be available for 70 people for presentations and video sessions.
- 5. There should be easy access to an international airport.
- 6. Reasonably priced hotel accommodation (maximum \$150 per night) should be available for 60 people, in reasonable proximity to the host institution.
